With regard to this, the company informs the user about its data protection and data processing practices, including the circumstances, purpose, legal basis, and duration of data processing activities (data collection, data processing, data usage, data transmission, etc.) based on Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation of the European Union (Regulation 679/2016, hereinafter: GDPR).

I. Basic concepts

"personal data": any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ("data subject"); an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier, or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural, or social identity of that natural person;

"data processing": any operation or set of operations which is performed on personal data or on sets of personal data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction;

"data controller": the natural or legal person, public authority, agency, or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data; where the purposes and means of such processing are determined by Union or Member State law, the controller or the specific criteria for its nomination may be provided for by Union or Member State law;

"data subject": any identified or identifiable natural person.

II. Scope of processed data

The Data Controller processes the following data of the data subjects for communication and contract fulfillment purposes:

name, email address, phone number, billing address

Surname and first name: necessary for contact, service ordering, and regular invoice issuance.

Email address: necessary for communication. Phone number: contact option, not mandatory.

Billing name and address: Necessary for regular invoice issuance.

III. Purposes of data processing

In connection with the provision of the service, the Data Controller processes personal data of individuals electronically for the following purposes:

communication with the data subjects, administration;

preparation, conclusion of contracts;

fulfillment of tax and accounting obligations;

legitimate interest of the Data Controller.

IV. Legal basis of data processing

The processing of personal data is based on the following legal grounds:

Processing of data subjects' data, contract conclusion and performance, administration

Legal basis: GDPR Article 6(1)(b) - preparation and performance of contracts

Legal basis: GDPR Article 6(1)(a) - consent of the data subject

Administration, communication

Legal basis: GDPR Article 6(1)(f) - legitimate interests of the contracting party

Legal basis: GDPR Article 6(1)(a) - consent of the data subject

Fulfillment of tax, accounting, and legal obligations

Legal basis: GDPR Article 6(1)(c) - compliance with a legal obligation to which the data controller is subject

V. Duration of Data Processing

The processing of voluntarily provided data during the completion of the contact form begins upon receipt of the inquiry message in the mailbox and lasts until the consent is withdrawn or, in its absence, for as long as necessary for the purpose. After this, the data will be automatically deleted from the Data Controller's system.

The Data Controller processes the personal data of the Data Subjects for the purpose of fulfilling legal obligations for the following duration:

- Retention period for documents and related papers: 8 (eight) years.

- The processing of voluntarily provided data during the completion of the contact form begins upon receipt of the inquiry message in the mailbox and lasts until the consent is withdrawn or, in its absence, for as long as necessary for the purpose. After this, the data will be automatically deleted from the Data Controller's system.

- Retention of data related to the performance of contracts: 5 (five) years.

VI. Automated Decision Making

The Data Controller does not carry out automated decision-making.

VII. Scope of Data Subjects

The individuals affected by data processing include users, interested parties, and clients who write to the email address provided on the contact page, request appointments or quotes by filling out the contact form, as well as individuals who contact the data controller through publicly available contact information. Furthermore, individuals who enter into a contractual relationship with the Data Controller are also included.

VIII. Circle of Authorized Persons

During the data processing period, personal data at the Data Controller is only accessible to the Data Controller's manager, members personally involved in the company's activities, and individuals whose access to this data is necessary to perform their duties. In addition, individuals who work for service providers or agents who provide services to the Data Controller may also have access to the data if access to this data is necessary to perform their job duties.

IX. Data Security

The Data Controller ensures the security of personal data through physical and technical protection measures appropriate to the level of technology, preventing unauthorized access,

unauthorized modification or transmission, intentional and accidental deletion, and destruction of data.

9.1. The Data Controller stores the personal data it manages in electronic form.

9.2. The Data Controller applies solutions that provide appropriate levels of security in line with the current state of technology to protect electronically managed data.

9.3. The Data Controller takes all necessary measures to ensure the security of the data subject's personal data and establishes the necessary technical and organizational measures and procedures to enforce GDPR regulations and other data and confidentiality rules. In this context, the Data Controller ensures:

- pseudonymization and encryption of personal data;
- continuous maintenance of the confidentiality, integrity, availability, and resilience of systems and services used for processing personal data;
- the ability to restore access to personal data and their availability in a timely manner in the event of a physical or technical incident;
- a procedure for regularly testing, assessing, and evaluating the effectiveness of technical and organizational measures taken to ensure the security of data processing.

9.4. The Data Controller ensures that the data recorded, stored, or processed is protected and prevents its accidental loss, unlawful destruction, unauthorized access, and unauthorized use, alteration, or dissemination.

9.5. The Data Controller's information system is protected by a firewall against unauthorized access.

X. Cookies

After writing a comment, the website stores the provided name, email, and website address in a cookie. The storage is for convenience purposes only, so that the information does not need to be automatically filled in during the next comment. The expiration period for cookies is 1 year. If we have a user account and are logged into this website, temporary cookies are set to determine whether the browser accepts cookies. These cookies do not contain personal information and are deleted when the browser is closed. When logging into the website, we create multiple cookies that save login information and display options for the editor. Login cookies are valid for two days, and the cookie storing editor display options is valid for one year. If we save our settings ("Remember me" option), the login will persist for two weeks. When we log out, login cookies are removed. When we edit a post or page, another cookie is stored in our browser. This cookie does not contain personal data; it simply stores the ID of the post we edited. Its validity expires after one day.

Cookies commonly used on websites include the so-called "password-protected session cookies" and "security cookies" for which prior consent from data subjects is not required. The fact of data processing, the scope of processed data: Unique identifier, dates, timestamps. Circle of data subjects: All visitors to the website. Purpose of data processing: User identification and tracking of visitor behavior. Duration of data processing, deadline for deletion of data: Deleted upon closing the browser. Possible data controllers authorized to access the data: No personal data is processed using cookies by the data controller. Description of the data subjects' rights related to data processing: Visitors have the option to delete cookies in the browsers' Tools/Settings menu, usually under the Privacy settings. Legal basis for data processing: Prior consent from data subjects is not required if the sole purpose of using cookies is to transmit communications over an electronic communications network or if the service provider absolutely needs it to provide a service requested explicitly by the subscriber or user related to the information society. XIII. Rights of Data Subjects

13.1. Right to Information and Access to Personal Data

The data subject may request the Data Controller to provide information about the processing of data, its duration, and to ensure access to the data. The request for information may also extend to the source of the data processed by the Data Controller, the purpose and legal basis of the processing, the names and addresses of any data processors, activities related to data processing, and, if personal data are transferred, to whom and for what purpose the data of the data subject have been or will be disclosed.

13.2. Right to Rectification

The data subject may request the correction, modification, or supplementation of inaccurate personal data processed by the Data Controller.

13.3. Right to Erasure

The data subject may request the deletion of personal data processed by the Data Controller.

13.4. Right to Restriction of Processing

The data subject may request that the processing of personal data by the Data Controller be restricted if the data subject disputes the accuracy of the processed personal data or if the processing is unlawful, but instead of deleting the personal data, the data subject requests restriction of its use.

13.5. Right to Data Portability

The data subject may request to receive the personal data provided to the Data Controller and processed in an automated format, or to have it transmitted to another Data Controller.

13.6. Right to Object

The data subject may object to the processing of personal data for direct marketing purposes.

XIV. Data Breach

If a data breach is likely to result in a high risk to the rights and freedoms of natural persons, the Data Controller shall promptly inform the data subject of the data breach. The notification to the data subject shall clearly and understandably describe the nature of the data breach and provide the name and contact details of the data protection officer or other contact person providing further information; describe the likely consequences of the data breach; describe the measures taken or planned by the Data Controller to remedy the data breach, including, where applicable, measures to mitigate any adverse effects of the data breach. The data subject need not be informed if any of the following conditions are met: – the Data Controller has implemented appropriate technical and organizational measures, and these measures have been applied to the data affected by the data breach, particularly measures such as encryption that make the data unintelligible to unauthorized persons; – the Data Controller has taken further measures after the data breach to ensure that the high risk to the rights and freedoms of data subjects is not likely to materialize in the future; – providing the information would require disproportionate effort. In such cases, data subjects must be informed through public announcements or similar measures ensuring effective information of the data subjects. If the Data Controller has not yet informed the data subject of the data breach, the supervisory authority may, after considering

whether the data breach is likely to result in a high risk, require the data subject to be informed. The Data Controller shall notify the supervisory authority of the data breach without undue delay and, where feasible, no later than 72 hours after becoming aware of the data breach, unless the data breach is unlikely to result in a risk to the rights and freedoms of natural persons. If the notification is not made within 72 hours, the reasons for the delay must be provided.

XV. Complaint Handling

The data subject may request information from the Data Controller about data processing, and may request correction, modification, supplementation, objection, deletion, restriction, and exercise of data portability rights.
